2 Day Training Course Info for
Owners of Imported IPL Systems

Background

The popularity of Intense Pulsed Light systems has increased manifold over the last 5 years, and machines from overseas, mainly China, can be easily imported. The Therapeutic Goods Administration Australia does not approve these machines, and their use does incur fines in Australia.

These systems are supplied with manuals very often written in poor English, lack basic values for operators in regards to applications, and are very hard to understand for owners not trained in any aspect of beauty therapy or skin knowledge.

As the use of IPL systems is - as of yet – not legislated, anyone can use them to derive income. Without adequate training, the use of these IPL systems is unfortunately on a trial and error base, where the errors are being borne by clients.

Recent “Current Affairs” programs have shown very graphic examples of injuries by unfortunate clients.

What different Training Courses are available:

1. There are no State or Federal Government regulations for the use of IPL Systems.
2. **Our course is a Certificate Course – not a Government Accredited Course.**
3. Our course material is very closely aligned to the curriculum of above.
4. Government Accredited Courses run for over a period of up to 8 days and cost between \$ 2,500 and \$ 4,000, per person!

To attend these, the following pre-requisites are required:

Units required:

WRBCS305A Apply knowledge of skin biology to beauty treatments
WRBCS408A Apply knowledge of anatomy and physiology to beauty treatments
WRBCS409A Apply knowledge of skin science to beauty therapy treatments
WRBCS410A Apply knowledge of electricity to beauty therapy treatments
WRBCS411A Apply knowledge of nutrition to beauty therapy treatments

5. After completing the Government Accredited IPL course students will receive a Certificate of Attendance and once they have had twelve months practical experience they are entitled to the Government Qualification.

Our training is by no means a "university degree", and does not substitute the need of your own ongoing research, and copious taking of notes for each one of your treatments. However, with our training, you will be immediately confident to treating your clients for a large variety of skin complaints, and their hair reduction needs.

We come to your place of work, and train you and up to five staff on your machines and issue a certificate.

1. Delivery

Part I consists of a 12 module PowerPoint presentation by D. MCG. Clarkson, B.Sc., M. Phil, outlining the technical aspects of IPL systems, as well as hazards for the eyes and skin.

Part II consists of a multiple module PowerPoint presentation, outlining IPL applications for hair reduction treatments as well, as IPL applications for skin repair, pigmentation, vascular and acne treatments. Safety at the workplace and the necessity of Consent Forms, Medical History, Counter Indications and Melanoma awareness are addressed.

We supply a training handbook for every participant and concentrate particularly on the hands-on applications.

2. Time / Duration of Course

Training will be held for up to five people at your home or place of work on your own IPL system.

Generally 5 to 6 hours per day

3. What are Pulse Width, Pulse Delay and Joule, and why it is important to know the differences?
4. Screen Interface and Settings
5. Safety in a clinical environment
6. Client medical history and consent form
7. Client treatment forms and note taking
8. Skin types, hair colours and IPL
9. Principles of Hair, and Hair Reduction with IPL
10. Practical Hair Reduction Session with Volunteer

Day 2

1. Contra-indications to IPL
2. Photo Rejuvenation and Collagen Production with IPL.
3. Various forms of pigmentations, and the correct application of IPL
4. Differences between moles, naevi, lentigines, age spots, freckles
5. Melanoma awareness
6. Limitations of IPL with Melasma
7. Various forms of vascular lesions and the correct application of IPL, i.e. Telangiectasia, poikiloderma, cherry angioma, port wine stains and birthmarks, superficial hemangiomas and other vascular malformations.
8. Acne management and IPL
9. Practical application of pigmentation/vascular treatment on a volunteer
10. After care
